

Black Mountain Home for Children

Facility Use Guidelines:

1. Individuals, groups, and their guests may only be in those areas of the property they have reserved.
2. Abusive or foul language, violent behavior, and drug use are strictly prohibited on Home premises. Any persons exhibiting such behavior or behavior that fails to respect the Home's Statement of Faith will be required to leave the premises immediately.
3. Food and beverages may be served in Home facilities unless detailed otherwise in the facility use agreement. However, alcohol may not be served on Home property unless proper permits and approvals have been obtained by the lessee.
4. Smoking of any kind (i.e., cigarettes, e-cigarettes, pipes, etc.) is prohibited on all Home property.
5. Black Mountain Home is only providing standard facilities. Individuals or groups using Home property are responsible for supplying all of their materials (i.e., handouts, flip charts, markers, paper products, utensils, decorations, etc.).
6. All Home property and equipment (i.e., tables, chairs, cooking implements, projectors, etc.) must be returned to original placement, unless arranged otherwise prior to the event, in the same or better condition than it was found.
7. Clean-up is the responsibility of the group or individual reserving Home facilities. Black Mountain Home will provide general cleaning tools such as brooms, dust pans, vacuums, etc. The group or individual is responsible for all cleaners and disposable supplies such as detergent, floor cleaner, etc. Black Mountain Home staff will remove trash, but the group or individual is responsible for ensuring that all trash has been placed in proper trash receptacles.
8. Before leaving, all kitchen equipment, audio/visual equipment, and lights must be turned off. All doors must be locked upon departure.
