West Campus Facility Use Guidelines

1. The liability waiver form and acknowledgement of statement of faith must be signed prior to the use of Black Mountain Home (BMH) facilities.
2. Individuals, groups, and their guests may only be in those areas of the property they have reserved.
3. The following are prohibited: abusive or foul language, violent behavior, drug use, fireworks, firearms, pets, shaving cream activities, smoking of any kind (cigarettes, e-cigarettes, pipes, etc).
4. Alcohol may not be served on West Campus property without prior approval.
5. BMH is only providing standard facilities. Individuals or groups using BMH property are responsible for supplying all of their materials (handouts, flip charts, markers, paper products, decorations, etc.)
6. Please do not rearrange furniture in the buildings. Rocking chairs must remain on porches. Chairs and tables must remain at the dining hall.
7. Be mindful of traffic through camp. There are three private residences with access through the property. DO NOT block any roads.
8. If you are using a kitchen area, please use only the food you brought. BMH uses the Dining Hall walk-in food storage areas for campus events and retreats.
9. Please dispose of trash properly and latch dumpster to avoid unwanted wildlife. Trash and mixed recycling pick up is on Mondays and Thursdays. Be sure not to block dumpster.
10. Only burn firewood in campfire rings and ensure fire is out before leaving campfire.
11. Do not disturb statues, rock formations, wildlife, and foliage.
12. Quiet hours are between 11pm and 8am.
13. Thermostat must remain between 68 and 74 degrees.
14. All BMH property and equipment (tables, chairs, cooking implements, sound equipment, etc.) must be returned to original placement, unless otherwise discussed with BMH staff.
15. Clean up is the responsibility of the group or individual reserving BMH facilities. BMH will provide general cleaning tools such as brooms, dust pans, vacuums, etc. The group or individual is responsible for all cleaners and disposable supplies such as multi-purpose spray, detergent, floor cleaner, etc. Please complete Departure Checklist before leaving.
16. Fireplaces are NOT in working order.
